

- General feedback
- Team Recommendations:
  - Research other platforms. User experience is poor and reporting capabilities very limited.

  - Teacher/staff (30) 100% (+2) of committed teachers/staff attended!
  - Sponsors (6)
  - Early Bird tickets (60)
- General feedback
  - Venue

  - Day: Thurs vs Friday vs Saturday
    - Consensus in the past has been that Thursday is not ideal for working families/teachers
    - Friday is difficult for a lot of working families
    - Is Saturday desirable? Likely more expensive.
- Recommendations
  - Venue worked well aside from sound. Spring Fling was the third event in the space so this will likely be ironed out.
  - Bidding Owl presented several challenges for ticket sales/buy-in experiences.
  - Lock in date for next year ASAP to allow adequate time for planning.
    - April or May?
  - Kick off meeting in the fall.
  - Spring Fling committee roles:
    - Event chair
    - Communications
    - Auction chair/co-chair

- Buy-In Experiences
- Sponsorship chair to attend kickoff meeting (at a minimum) to ensure sponsors receive all Spring Fling-related deliverables
- Avoid scramble for sponsors. Allocate % of annual sponsorship to Spring Fling discretionary budget.
- Volunteers: revisit the idea of volunteering to help run other "friends of" spring fundraisers and vice versa was brought up in fall, we should look into this.
- Reevaluate process for teacher/staff tickets. Either set a uniform teacher/staff ticket price (low) or commit to offset costs not covered by teacher sponsorship funds.
- Revisit option for a set number of volunteer or other discounted tickets for community members unable to afford full price. Clear process would need to be in place.

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- Will speak with BB about speakers and acoustics
- Recommend to lock in the date a soon as possible
- Lot's of research on venues this year. Do want to lock in date for next year.
- Need new auction site. Molly Maier is researching. Not user friendly. Not management friendly.
- Should we expect additional invoices from Bidding Owl for their charge? Answer Yes.
- What date do we want to do this year?
- April or May?
- Meagan will reach out to BB and see what dates are available and send out a poll to the group.
- Chappell and Burr have already rebooked for their similar dates
- Meagan will not be chairing the Committee next year.
- Meagan recommendations Specific person for Communications
- Buy-In parties need to be
- Julia suggested doing teacher Buy-In parties in fall coordinated with Booosterfest. Gives teachers more time to plan and host party
- Sponsorship Chair have a meeting at the very beginning of the planning
- Mary McConville she and Meg are working on ideas for sponsorships
- Julia said maybe a sponsor for matching teachers

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- Process for teacher and staff tickets. Need to review the process and see if we can work it better.
- Mr Fernandez said a lot of teachers were so happy to go. They enjoyed the evening. Partnership between home and school. Felt like a fun wedding.
- Question would teachers still come if they had to pay a reduced ticket price?
   Maybe \$25. Mr Fernandez said that they probably would if it was significant
   reduction. \$25. Meagan they do need to review the process of funding teachers for next year
