Alcohol Update:

- Hiccup with new Chicago laws many distributors don't want to donate alcohol
 due to IL laws (one said they couldn't because of venue's permanent liquor
 license)
- Any updates from Kyla's connections and/or Ms.Davos regarding Foremost? Ms. Davos found out this past weekend that her cousin sold the store. But she is
 still willing to buy 300 bottles of Charles Shaw (given rules, I'm not sure how we
 can make this happen unless I talk to Trader Joe's and see if they would let
 Artifact buy it at cost and then have Ms. Davos reimburse us?)
- Potential workaround to this by having venue buy alcohol at cost (paid for by Boosters) and then the provider gives Boosters an equivalent \$ donation
- Supplemental Bar Package (cheaper than full bar package)-alcohol partially donated (ie.beer) and we supplement missing alcohol through Artifacts using above work around (\$8/guest-beer+wine, \$10/guest liquor)
- Ticketed alcohol concept-each guest gets beverage tickets and Boosters is invoiced after event for each ticket
- Artifact Events has preferred distributors but can purchase from any, including liquor stores. However, Jen mentioned that ordering through a distributor is going to be more cost effective.
- Confirmed we can NOT purchase alcohol from anyone but Artifacts and any donated alcohol MUST be delivered to Artifact Events (Chicago city law). We can not bring in any donated alcohol ourselves.
 - Mary going to ask Chicago Winery (Aaron Graves Bateman dad) for 2 kegs
 - Kyla to ask friend from Goose Island for 2 kegs
 - (will need to get buckets/garbage cans and kegorators/taps for each)
 - Need most recent 990 for Tito's donation request Kyla

We need to figure out what we are going to do for glasses

- Rent? Purchase? Have rocks glasses made by Hound Custom? (cost?) Can we build this cost into ticket price? So you get a glass with your ticket at check-in? Costco or Restaurant depot plasticware?
 - Hound Custom is an option
 - Perhaps the caterer we get can provide-reached out to caterers regarding this
 - Purchase plastic ones from Costc

Food Update:

***AE policy is that we have to have members of the catering team there to service the event-we cannot just have food dropped and we set-up/clean up (exception for late night bites+dessert). Artifacts can provide 2 team members if we get food dropped for an additional \$420 total.
