
30% attendance increase from last year with over 1,300 people

20% increase in Net raised (but doesn't include Pizza Y Pan's donation yet) at \$8,019.42 **Reminder that BOOOsterfest is supposed to be a monetarily accessible all-school community building event. Raising money is a bonus in this case**

Top notes from the debrief last Wednesday:

- 1. BOOOsterfest chair needs a co-chair
- 2. Haunted House needs a separate volunteer coordinator on site (if 8th grade students are involved it ideally would be an 8th grade teacher

- 3. We need more lights in the Haunted House and Jurassic Adventure, and more signs for how many tickets things cost
- 4. Trunk or Treat was a great addition! But we need an entrance and exit next year, with instructions to only go through once, or charge 1 ticket per child to help with the flow. Try to get candy donations early in the season.
- 5. Send out Signup Genius earlier, and set up a signup genius to help with flyering
- 6. Prepare tickets in increments of 5 ahead of time
- 7. Put Pie in the face drawing next to the pie in the face, and keep the raffle separate need better signage to draw attention
 - a. Admin maybe tied to the Walkathon?
- 8. Use a different Vendor for the bouncy house City uses Jumping Jack Program? Would Andrade entertain using them?
- 9. Get a 4th food vendor (hot dogs was recommended, something easy for kids)
- 10. Create an agreement with the food vendors ahead of time regarding the amount they aive back
- 11. Professional photographer for the photo backdrop?
