- Bateman Boosters is a not-for-profit organization dedicated to supporting our community school. We are parents, neighbors and community friends committed to enhancing the learning experience for all Bateman students through fundraising. All are welcome.
- Since 2016, Bateman Boosters have had the pleasure of raising more than \$190,000.
 We have been able to support the fine arts program, replace the auditorium curtains (from the 50's!), install an electronic message board, purchase new classroom libraries, provide a gymnasium barrier, install modern water fountains with bottle filling stations, purchase promethean boards for each classroom, and pay for updates to the auditorium.
- With your generous support we hope to reach our highest annual fundraising goal ever in 2023-2024, \$67,000.
- As always, the use of these funds is coordinated with our school administration and staff
 with an aim at projects that benefit all students in every grade level. Our goal for this
 year impacts the entire Bateman community as we raise funds for Blaze Plays: creating
 movement and play opportunities through supporting the PE program and rebuilding the
 playground to be more inclusive and safer.
