- Alcohol donation spreadsheet has been started: <u>Alcohol Donations/Requests for Spring</u>

#### • Alcohol Update:

- Confirmed donated alcohol:
  - 10 cases from Goose Island
  - 14 cases from Spiteful (mix of IPA & Lager)
  - Vodka from Tito's (how much?)
  - 6 cases of wine from Chicago Winery
- Hiccup with new Chicago laws many distributors don't want to donate alcohol due to IL laws (one said they couldn't because of venue's permanent liquor license)
- Potential workaround to this by having venue buy alcohol at cost (paid for by Boosters) and then the provider gives Boosters an equivalent \$ donation
- Supplemental Bar Package (cheaper than full bar package)-alcohol partially donated (ie.beer) and we supplement missing alcohol through Artifacts using above work around (\$8/guest-beer+wine, \$10/guest liquor)
- Artifact Events has preferred distributors but can purchase from any, including liquor stores. However, Jen mentioned that ordering through a distributor is going to be more cost effective.
- Confirmed we can NOT purchase alcohol from anyone but Artifacts and any donated alcohol MUST be delivered to Artifact Events (Chicago city law). We can not bring in any donated alcohol ourselves.
- CH Distillery do not donate but have non-profit prices that are VERY desirable
- Idea from Michael Ruiz: If we can't get any other liquor, we could make a few speciality Bateman vodka drinks that patrons can choose from.
- Glassware: will purchase plasticware from Costco or Restaurant supply
  - \$10.99 for 150 Chinet 10oz cups at Costco
  - Amazon has larger size (16oz)
  - Or do we want a commemorative glass for purchase?

# • Food Update:

\*\*\*AE policy is that we have to have members of the catering team there to service the event-we cannot just have food dropped and we set-up/clean up (exception for late night bites+dessert). Artifacts can provide 2 team members if we get food dropped for an additional \$420 total.

# Photo Booth Update (KW):

- Ayala Photo and Media LLC has offered to provide a 360 photo booth from 7-10:30 for a discounted cost of \$350 (regularly \$650), it includes: Unlimited use of 360 booth from 7:00 to 10:30. Prop table, LED lights, Gold stanchions with red velvet ropes, Red Carpet, Our (or Andrade's) logo on the videos, Song of your choosing for videos, Instant video sharing, Access to online video gallery, All battery powered set up to place 360 booth virtually anywhere. They are a newer company and in exchange for the reduced cost they have asked that they are allowed to use some of the videos for their social media and webpage.
